

KILKENNY CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING August 11, 2022

There was a regular meeting of the Kilkenny City Council held in Council Chambers on August 11, 2022.

- 1. Call to Order: Mayor Cameron Hankins called the meeting to order at 6:42 pm.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance:
- **3. Approval of Minutes:** Special Meeting held July 14, 2022. Motion by Tammy Holicky, second by Bob Busta to approve minutes as written. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.

8. Presentations:

- A) Sheriff Department: No immediate concerns. Complaints about the detour and trying to keep cars off closed roads. Council members mentioned speeding in town and bicyclist does not obey road signs. Resident made concern on a fire hydrant violation.
- **B) PeopleService:** North lift station needs to be fixed St. Peter Well Drilling will pump it.
- C) Toy Box Saloon: Toy Box will close off all of Oak Street so employees can park safely.

9. New Business:

- A) Resolution 2022-6 Establishing Address: Motion by Tammy Holicky, seconded by Terry Ferch to pass resolution 2022-6 establishing address 161 Dodd Road W for Lori Storeing. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.
- **B) KLM and Maguire Iron Contracts:** Motion by Tammy Holicky, seconded by Terry Ferch to accept KLM Engineering 10- year service agreement given that it changes to 50,000- gallon instead of 30,000- gallon standpipe water storage. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.
- C) Turf Tech Quote Round Up Spray to Side Walks \$213.75: Motion by Terry Ferch, seconded by Bob Busta to accept Turf Tech quote of \$213.75 to spray the sidewalks. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.

D) Pirkl Gas Contract: \$1.89 Prepay or \$1.99 monthly (Prepay due September 1st)

Motion by Terry Ferch, seconded by Bob Busta to donate \$100.00 to Hillers Last Call for their kickball tournament. In return we receive \$100 worth of merchandise for halfway.
