- 1. Call to Order. Mayor Cameron Hankins called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

- **3.** Approval of Agenda: Motion by Terry Ferch, seconded by Bob Busta to approve the agenda as written. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.

 - a. 2023 Annual Budget: Tara presented the proposed budget worksheet for 2022, along with past year's budgets so we could compare and make adjustments as needed. Council agreed to go through the budget line by line. The City has been having problems with the North lift station and had to increase so we are able to repair and maintain our water/sewer systems. The Council decreased or removed budgets to the library and park, as needed. There was discussion to add a drop off box to the city office for water bills to save money. Fire Department will talk again about having gambling at the Toy Box Saloon to help pay the Sheriffs Department. Once passed at the next council meeting, Tara will present us with the final budget and copy of the Levy that will be sent to the County.
